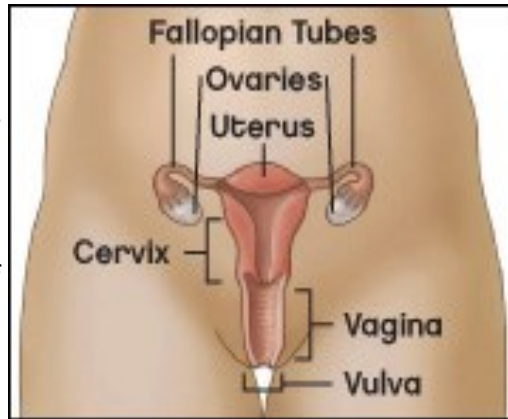

## What is cervical cancer?

Cervical cancer is cancer of the cervix. The cervix is the lower part of the uterus, or womb, and is situated at the top of the vagina. Cervical cancer develops when abnormal cells in the lining of the cervix begin to multiply out of control and form pre-cancerous lesions. If undetected, these lesions can develop into tumors and spread into the surrounding tissue.



Cervical cancer is the second most common cancer in Malaysia. The good news is, unlike other cancers, cervical cancer is preventable and can be cured if detected early.

## What causes cervical cancer?

Cervical cancer is caused by infection with certain types of a common virus, called human papillomavirus, or HPV. The virus is transmitted through genital skin to skin contact so it can affect virtually any woman, regardless of her age or lifestyle. Sexual intercourse is not necessary to become infected.

It is estimated that about four out of five sexually active women will have an HPV infection during their lifetime even if they've only one or two sexual partners. Condoms reduce the risk but are not fully protective.

## Preventing Cervical Cancer

### • Have Regular Pap Smear

Your risk of developing cervical cancer can be reduced by having regular pap smears which are an early detection screening program. Always make sure you receive the result of your Pap test from your healthcare professional.

### • Vaccination

It is now possible to be vaccinated against cervical cancer. The vaccine can prevent most cases of cervical cancer if given before a girl or woman is exposed to the virus.
